Oak Wilt Pruning Moratorium Begins April 1


With spring finally arriving to the Centre Region, the Township will be activating and enforcing its oak wilt pruning moratorium from April 1st through October 31st.

Owners are reminded that all dogs over three (3) months of age must be registered. Dogs must be under control and on a leash of no longer than six (6) feet at all times. The Tudek Dog Park is the only off-leash dog area in the Township.

Apply for a Food Truck Permit



Food truck operators in Ferguson Township are required to obtain a Mobile Food Vendor zoning permit at no cost in 2024, as well as a Health Permit. Both permits must be displayed in the food truck's windows. Annual renewal is required.
